# Willow Estates Berm Project

## What's happening?

To protect the people and property in Drumheller from loss due to flooding, Wilco Contractors Southwest Inc. is constructing the Willow Estates Berm. This project is part of the Flood Mitigation and Climate Adaptation System, managed by the Resiliency and Flood Mitigation Office.



### What to expect:

Below are the things to be aware of related to this project. Crews will make every effort to minimize the effect their work has on daily activities and will follow all applicable standards and bylaws.

- Phase 1: Pre-Construction (Mobilization): mid-August early-September 2022
- **Phase 2:** Tree Clearing: September 2022
- Phase 3: Dike Construction: mid-September mid-November 2022
- **Phase 4:** 7 Ave E raising, Final Cleanup and Landscaping: Spring 2023

#### **Dates**

This work is scheduled to commence mid-August and will continue until the ground freezes, with work along 7 Ave E taking place in the Spring of 2023. Final cleanup and landscaping may occur in Spring 2023.

### Road closures, pathways closures, detours, parking, and access:

- 7 Ave will be partially closed (single lane traffic) for a limited time between mid-September to mid-November 2022 and April – May 2023 (dates TBD).
- A small section of the path within the park adjacent to Riverside Drive will be permanently removed to make room for the berm.
- Access to the green space behind residences, for residents, will be closed temporarily between September and November (dates TBD).
- Willow Point and Riverside Gardens residences will remain accessible throughout construction.
- Trucks will be hauling dirt to the project site, so please expect minor traffic delays and drive with caution.
